## AN ACT to amend the Environment Protection Act 1973 [Royal Assent 15 October 1991]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows: -

#### Short title

1-This Act may be cited as the Environment Protection Amendment Act 1991.

#### Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

### Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Environment Protection Act 1973\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

## Section 7 amended (Environment Protection Advisory Council)

- 4—Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsections (2) and (3) and substituting the following subsections : -
  - (2) The council shall consist of 11 members appointed by the Minister.
  - (3) The council shall consist of a chairperson, being a person nominated by the Department, and-
    - (a) one person nominated by each of the following bodies:—
      - (i) the Municipal Association of Tasmania:
      - (ii) the Tasmanian Conservation Trust;
      - (iii) the Tasmanian Trades and Labor Council: and
    - (b) 2 persons nominated by the Commonwealth Industrial Scientific and Research Organisation; and
    - (c) 2 persons nominated by the Tasmanian Industry Association for Environmental Control; and
    - (d) 3 persons nominated by the University of Tasmania, one of whom shall be a person having expertise in environmental studies.

- (3A) The Minister may require a body referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c) or (d) of subsection (3) to submit a nomination within a specified period.
  - (3B) If a body referred to in—
    - (a) subparagraphs (i) to (iii) of paragraph (a);
- (b) paragraph (b), (c) or (d) of subsection (3) fails to comply with subsection (3A), the Minister may nominate a person for the purposes of that subparagraph or paragraph, as the case requires.
- (3c) If a body referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c) or (d) of subsection (3) changes its name, the Governor may, by order, amend that paragraph by substituting the body's new name.
- (3D) If a body referred to in paragraph (a), (b), (c) or (d) of subsection (3) ceases to exist—
  - (a) the Governor may, by order, amend that paragraph by substituting the name of a body which the Governor is satisfied substantially represents the interests represented by the body that has ceased to exist; and
  - (b) a member of the council who represents that body ceases to be a member of the council Minister and the may, on recommendation of the other body referred to in paragraph (a) of this subsection, appoint a person to be a member of the council for the remainder of the term of the person who has ceased to be a member of the council.

## Section 9 amended (Committees)

5—Section 9 (4) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "3 years" and substituting "2 years".

## Section 55 amended (Regulations)

- 6-Section 55 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:
  - (1) ", on the (a) by omitting from subsection recommendation of the council,";

(b) by omitting from subsection (6) ", on the recommendation of the Council,".

# Schedule 2 amended (Provisions with respect to membership of Council)

7—Schedule 2 to the Principal Act is amended by omitting from clause 2 "3 years" (twice occurring) and substituting "2 years".

## Schedule 3 amended (Provisions with respect to meetings of Council)

- 8-Schedule 3 to the Principal Act is amended as follows:-
  - (a) by omitting from clause 1 "chairman" (twice occurring) and substituting "chairperson";
  - (b) by omitting from clause 2 "chairman" and substituting "chairperson";
  - (c) by omitting from clause 2 "3 members" and substituting "6 members";
  - (d) by omitting from clause 3 (1) "Four members" and substituting "Six members";
  - (e) by omitting from clause 4 (1) "chairman" and substituting "chairperson";
  - (f) by omitting from clause 4 (1) "he" and substituting "the chairperson";
  - (g) by omitting from clause 4 (2) "chairman" and substituting "chairperson".

#### **Transitional**

9—The appointment of a person who was a member of the Environment Protection Advisory Council immediately before the commencement of this Act is terminated upon the commencement of this Act, but that person may be re-appointed as a member of the council in accordance with the Principal Act as amended by this Act.
