- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Penguin Water Act short title and 1952.
- (2) The Penguin Water Act 1950, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Borrowing therefrom the word "twenty" and substituting therefor the powers. word "thirty".
