Short title and citation.

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Forestry Act 1957.

(2) The Forestry Act 1954 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Special licences. 2 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) thereof the words "a further period of not more than three months" and substituting therefor the words `any further period or periods not exceeding twelve months in the aggregate".
