AN ACT to amend the Forestry Act 1954 to make further provision with respect to the special licence granted under that Act.

[Royal Assent 29 June 1983]

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Forestry Amendment Act 1983. Short title.
- 2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the commenceroyal assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the Forestry Act 1954* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Forestry Amendment

Amendment of section 3 of Principal Act (Special licence to take pulpwood, &c., from certain areas).

- 4—Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by inserting in paragraph (aa) of subsection (2) " and " after "licence:":
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection (2)"licence; and" and substituting "licence.";
 - (c) by omitting paragraph (b) of subsection (2);
 - (d) by omitting subsections (3) to (7) inclusive and substituting the following subsections:-
 - (3) Notwithstanding any provision of a special licence under this section, the Governor may suspend the licence for any period or periods not exceeding 2 years in the aggregate.
 - (4) Notwithstanding any provision of a special licence under this section, the Governor may revoke the licence.
 - (5) The power of revocation referred to in subsection (4) may be exercised whether or not the special licence is suspended pursuant to subsection (3) at the time of the exercise of the power of revocation.
