

A.D. AN ACT to provide for the Application of the 1934. Moneys granted by the Commonwealth to this State for the purpose of Affording Relief [29 September, 1934.] to Fruit Growers.

W HEREAS by the Financial Relief Act 1934 of the Common-Preamble. wealth it is enacted inter alia that the sum of seventy thousand two hundred and thirty-one pounds shall be granted by the Commonwealth by way of financial assistance to this State, and that that sum shall be so granted upon condition that it is applied by the State for the benefit and assistance of fruit growers :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :----

1 This Act may be cited as the Fruit Growers' Relief Act 1934.

Fruit Growers' Relief.

2 In this Act-

Interpretation.

"Fruit grower" means a grower of apples or pears or both:

- "The Commonwealth Act" means the Financial Relief Act 1934 of the Commonwealth:
- "The Suspense Account" means the account kept pursuant to section three.

Fruit Growers' Relief Suspense Account. 3-(1) Upon the commencement of this Act, there shall be opened and kept in the books of the Treasury an account to be called "The Fruit Growers' Relief Suspense Account, 1934."

(2) There shall be paid and credited to the Suspense Account all moneys received by this State under the provisions of the Common-wealth Act.

Application of moneys.

4 The amount standing to the credit of the Suspense Account after payment thereout of the expenses of the distribution thereof shall be paid and applied by the Treasurer, as may be prescribed, for the benefit and assistance of fruit growers.

Regulations.

5 The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act.
