BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Glenorchy Sewerage Act short title. 1943.
- 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the Amendment words "separate local" in paragraph I. of Section five.

Transitory provisions.

3 During the war in which His Majesty is at present engaged, and during a period not exceeding twelve months after the termination thereof, the Council may—

- I. After sewers have been laid in any part of the area, by resolution of the Council, declare that as from a date, not prior to the twenty-eighth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, any property in such part may, in the opinion of the Council, be conveniently served by any sewer; and thereupon such property shall be deemed and taken to be a sewered property within the meaning of the Principal Act as from the date so specified: and
- II. In respect of any such property, exercise the power conferred by subsection (2) of section twenty of the Principal Act, by notice in writing under the hand of the Council Clerk in lieu of the further general notice referred to in the said subsection; and in such case the reference to the further general notice in section twenty-one of the Principal Act shall be deemed to be to the aforesaid notice in writing.
