AN ACT to amend the *Hobart Bridge Act 1936*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Hobart Bridge Act 1943*. Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting at the end of section six thereof the following new subsection (5)— Amendment of 1 Edw. VIII. No. 33, s. 6.

“(5) All rights and exemptions under the *Traffic Act 1925*, and the Acts incorporated therewith which are applicable to the Hobart City Council in respect of its transport services shall apply to the company in respect of any transport service carried on by it in pursuance of subsection (1) hereof.”

**3**—(1) Upon receipt of a certificate by the Director that the bridge has been completed so far as regards all major essentials and that the same may be safely opened and used for traffic by the public the Governor by proclamation may grant to the Company provisionally a franchise in accordance with the provisions of subsection (2) of section six of the Principal Act, for a period not exceeding three months from the date thereof.

(2) Such provisional franchise shall be conditioned on the execution by the Company not later than three months after the date of such proclamation, of all works necessary for the entire completion of the bridge and all reasonable accessories thereto and in default thereof the provisional franchise shall cease and determine at the expiration of the said period of three months but without prejudice to the provisions of section six of the Principal Act.
