AN ACT to amend the Industrial Development Act 1954 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the powers of the Minister under that Act.

[Royal Assent 19 July 1983]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Industrial Development Amendment Act 1983*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent. Commencement.

3—Section 8 (1) of the *Industrial Development Act 1954** is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) “ State; and ” and substituting “ State;”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) “ State.” and substituting “ State; and ”;
- (c) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (c):—
 - (d) make grants on such terms and conditions as are approved by the Treasurer for the purpose of retaining industry carried on in this State.
