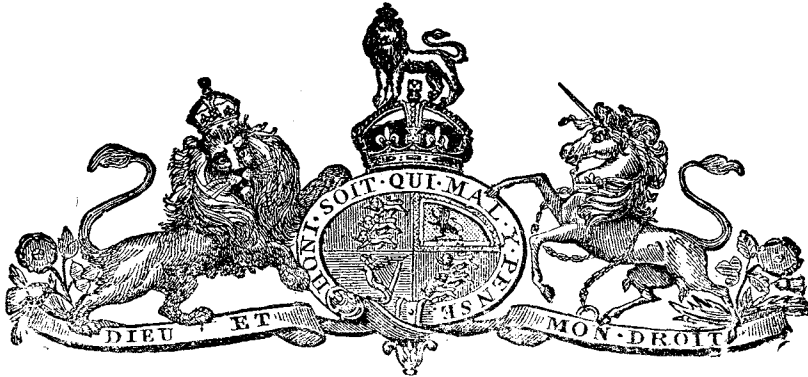

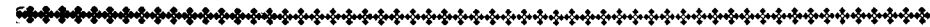

1. Short title.
2. Authority to General Manager to pay £10,000 out of Reserve Funds to Treasurer.



AN ACT to authorise the Tasmanian Government Insurance General Manager to pay to the Treasurer the sum of ten thousand pounds out of the Reserve Funds created under the *Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919*. [12 December, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Insurance Reserve Funds Payment Act 1934*. Short title.

2—(1) Subject to the approval of the Auditor-General, the Tasmanian Government Insurance General Manager may pay to the Treasurer the sum of ten thousand pounds out of the Reserve Funds created under the *Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919*.

Authority to General Manager to pay £10,000 out of Reserve Funds to Treasurer.

(2) The said sum shall be paid into and form part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.
