AN ACT to amend the Justices Act 1959.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Justices Amendment Act* Short title. (No. 2) 1988.

2—In this Act, the *Justices Act 1959** is referred to as the Principal Act. Principal Act.

3—Section 74c (1) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph:—

(a) to be imprisoned for his offence, may suspend the execution of the whole or part of the sentence; or
