- (2) The Housing Agreement Act 1961 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section four of the Principal Act is amended by omitting Powers of the Treasurer from subsection (1) thereof the words "fourteen million" in carrying and substituting therefor the words "fifteen million five agreement. hundred thousand".

JUDGES' SALARIES.

No. 26 of 1965.

AN ACT to amend the *Judges' Salaries Act* 1920. [12 October 1965.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Judges' Salaries Act Short title and citation.
- (2) The Judges' Salaries Act 1920, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section two of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—
- "2 There is payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Judges' (which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly)—
 - (a) to the person for the time being holding the office of Chief Justice, a salary at the rate of seven thousand pounds a year; and
 - (b) to each person for the time being holding the office of puisne judge, a salary at the rate of six thousand two hundred pounds a year.".
