ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and commencement.
2. Withdrawal of lands described in schedule from operation of the *Closer Settlement Act 1929*, and reservation thereof for the purposes of a gaol.
3. Closer Settlement Act (Soldiers' Account) to be credited with £8166.
4. Power to Treasurer to reappropriate £8166.

AN ACT to provide for the withdrawal of certain Lands vested in His Majesty for the purposes of the *Closer Settlement Act 1929* from the operation of that Act, and for the Reservation of such Lands for the purpose of the Establishment thereon of a Gaol to be known as "Kilderry Farm Gaol".

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Kilderry Farm Gaol (Land Reservation) Act 1937*, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven.

2 The several lands described in the schedule, and which are now vested in His Majesty and held by the Minister of Agriculture for the purposes of the *Closer Settlement Act 1929*, are hereby withdrawn from, and declared to be no longer subject to, the operation of that Act, and are hereby reserved for the purpose of the establishment thereon under the *Prison Act 1868* of a gaol to be known as "Kilderry Farm Gaol," which is hereby declared to be appointed and established for the purposes of that Act.

3 The *Closer Settlement Act (Soldiers')* Account kept in the books of the Treasury shall be credited by the Treasurer with the sum of eight thousand one hundred and sixty-six pounds, such sum representing the value, as at the commencement of this Act, of the said lands and all improvements thereon.

4 For the purpose of establishing such credit as aforesaid it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate from the *Closer Settlement Act (Soldiers')* Loan Account a sum not exceeding the said sum of eight thousand one hundred and sixty-six pounds.

THE SCHEDULE.

Firstly all that piece of land situate in the Parish of Lansdowne in the County of Monmouth in Tasmania containing 1442 acres 2 roods 5 perches the same being bounded on the north-west by 14 chains 50 links south-westerly along Lot 16,089 purchased by Duncan Goodsell along a reserved road and again along that lot commencing at the east angle of that lot on Johnny's Creek on the north-east by 22 chains 96 links north-westerly in three bearings also along that lot again on the north-west and south-west by 68 chains 15 links south-westerly and south-easterly in several bearings along Lots 16,090 16,830 20,664 and 586 purchased by Robert George Triffitt Elizabeth Georgina Triffitt Elizabeth Brasington and James Gibson respectively along a reserved road and again

along those lots again on the south-west by 44 chains 72 links south-easterly in several bearings along 479 acres acquired for soldier settlement and leased by Edward Gadsden Terry and William Garrard Terry again on the north-west by 115 chains 56 links south-westerly in several bearings also along that lease on the south-west by 58 chains 79 links south-easterly in several bearings along the Main-road from Macquarie Plains to Hobart again on the south-east by 32 chains north-easterly in several bearings along land granted to Bryan Bennett and along land purchased by Bryan Bennett on the south-west by 31 chains 63 links south-easterly in several bearings also along that land purchased by Bryan Bennett aforesaid again on the south-west and south-east by 11 chains 39 links south-easterly and north-easterly in several bearings again along the Main-road from Macquarie Plains to Hobart aforesaid on the north-east and north-west by 94 chains 11 links north-easterly and north-westerly in several bearings along lands granted to Gamaliel Butler and Joseph Allport and Cornelius Driscoll and George Cartwright respectively and along Crown land to Johnny's Creek aforesaid and thence by that creek to the point of commencement.

Secondly all that piece of land situate in the parish and county aforesaid containing 11 acres 2 roods 19 perches the same being bounded on the south-west by 12 chains 15 $\frac{7}{10}$ links south-easterly along 123 acres granted to Alfred Garrett commencing at a point on the Main-road from Macquarie Plains to Hobart aforesaid distant 2 chains 80 links south-easterly from the north angle of that grant on the south-east by 13 chains 96 $\frac{1}{2}$ links north-easterly along land granted to Bridget Anastasia Mansfield and along a reserved road to the aforesaid main road and thence on the north-east by 19 chains 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ links north-westerly in several bearings along that main road to the point of commencement.

Thirdly all that piece of land situate in the parish and county aforesaid containing 12 acres 2 roods 7 perches the same being bounded on the south-east by 18 chains 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ links north-easterly in three bearings along 123 acres granted to Alfred Garrett aforesaid commencing at the west angle of that land on the River Derwent on the north-east by 28 chains 47 $\frac{7}{10}$ links north-westerly in several bearings along the Main-road from Macquarie Plains to Hobart aforesaid on the north-west by 1 chain 50 links or thereabouts along portion of 528 acres located to R. Brooks to the River Derwent aforesaid and thence by that river to the point of commencement.
