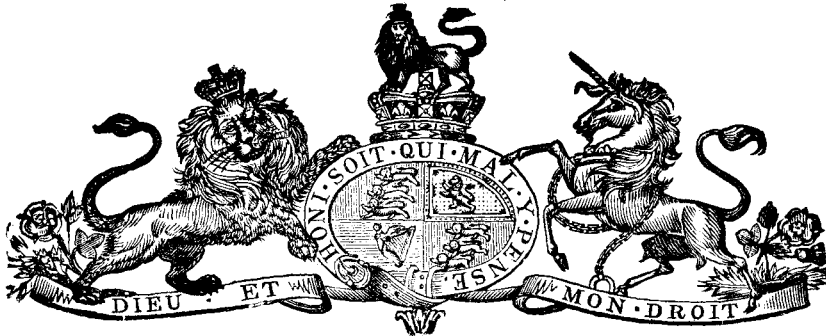

AN ACT to amend the *Kermadie Wood-pulp and Paper Industry Act 1933.* A.D. 1934.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Kermadie Wood-pulp and Paper Industry Act 1934.* Short title,

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by expunging from schedule (5) thereto the descriptions therein contained.

**3** The Governor, by proclamation, may declare that an area not exceeding seven thousand acres to be specified in such proclamation shall be substituted for the areas defined in schedule (5) to the Principal Act, and thereupon the area so specified shall be deemed to be comprised in the said schedule, and shall be subject to the provisions of that Act in the same manner and to the same extent as if the same had been originally defined therein.
