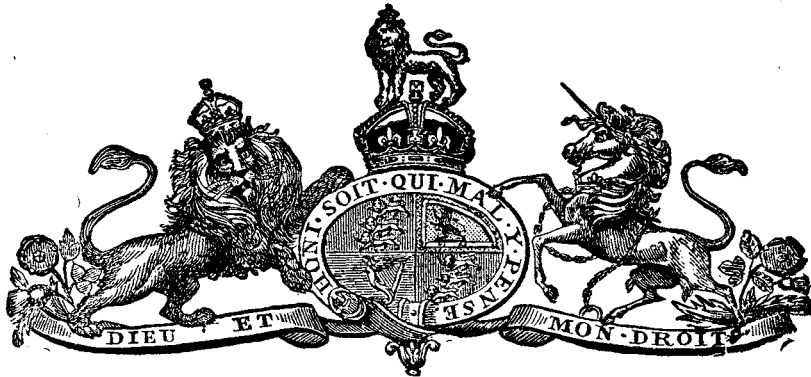

AN ACT to amend the *Licensing Act* 1932.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act* 1934.

- 2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—
- I. By inserting at the end of section twenty thereof the following new subsection (5)—
- “ (5) If at the time and place appointed for any sitting a quorum of the Court is not present, any member of the Court, or, if none is present, the clerk, may adjourn such sitting.”:
- Section 20.
- Section 24.
- II. By expunging paragraph v. of subsection (1) of section twenty-four thereof and substituting therefor the following new paragraph v.—
- “ v. For every wholesale licence, if the same is in respect of premises—
- (a) At one place only : Twenty-five pounds :
- (b) At two different places : Forty pounds :
- (c) At more than two different places : Fifty pounds.” :
- Section 36.
- III. By inserting after subsection (2) of section thirty-six thereof the following new subsection (3)—
- “ (3) Any advertisement required by this section, other than an advertisement of an application for a provisional certificate, may be published in a newspaper published in the district, although the same is not a daily newspaper.”:
- Section 42.
- IV. As to section forty-two thereof—
- (a) By inserting after the word “ Court ” at the end of subsection (6) the words “ or the Chairman ”: and
- (b) By adding at the end of subsection (7) the words “ but if in the opinion of the Chairman the work is of an urgent nature the Chairman may consider such plans and specifications, and if he approves the same the applicant may proceed therewith.”:

- V. By inserting after subsection (7) of section sixty-seven thereof the following new subsection (8):—
- “ (8) A wholesale licence shall not—
- i. Be granted except in respect of premises which the Commissioner of Police has reported to be suitable for the purpose : or
- ii. Authorise the holder to sell liquor except as provided by section twenty-two ” :

- VI. By inserting at the foot of paragraph vii. of subsection (11) of section ninety-seven thereof (as inserted by the *Licensing Act 1933*) the words “ Penalty : Five pounds ”: and

VII. By deleting from section one hundred and sixteen thereof Section 116. A.D. 1934. the figures "(1)" and "(2)" and all the words from the word "shall" in the second line of subsection (1) down to the word "proceeding" in the first line of subsection (2) inclusive.

**3** The *Licensing Act* 1933 is hereby amended by deleting from paragraph VI. of section two thereof the words and figure "of subsection (2)."
