AN ACT to amend the Licensing Act 1932. [6 December, 1937.]

A.D. 1937.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act* 1937.

Short title.

2 So much of the *Licensing Act* 1933, as is not already Repeal of 22 repealed, is hereby repealed.

Application of section 56 of Principal Act in certain cases.

3 Any person, who, in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (4) of section fifty-six of the Principal Act (as inserted by proclamation gazetted on the eighth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six), gave notice of appeal against any order, decision, or determination of a court under that Act, may, within twenty-one days after the passing of this Act, again give notice of such appeal, and commence his appeal de novo, and may have the same heard and determined upon the merits.
