

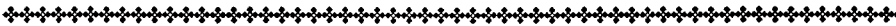


LAUNCESTON CORPORATION AMENDMENT ACT 1983

AN ACT to amend the Launceston Corporation Act 1963.

[Royal Assent 11 January 1984]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Launceston Corporation Amendment Act 1983*. Short title.

Commence-
ment.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Launceston Corporation Act 1963** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4—(1) Section 73 (2) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “ or inscribed stock or other securities of the Commonwealth ” and substituting “ , inscribed stock or other securities of the Commonwealth, or bills of exchange that are accepted without qualification by any bank ”.

(2) Section 73 of the Principal Act is further amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):—

(3) In subsection (2), “ bank ” means a bank as defined in section 5 (1) of the *Banking Act 1959* of the Commonwealth.

5—Section 74 of the Principal Act is repealed.
