

LOAN FUND APPROPRIATION 1965-1966.

No. 29 of 1965.

AN ACT to authorize the issue and application of moneys from the Loan Fund for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1966, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

[25 October 1965.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Loan Fund Appropriation Act 1965-1966*. Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July 1964.

2—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan Fund the sum of £16,031,000. Issue and application of moneys from the Loan Fund.

(2) The sum issued out of the Loan Fund under the authority of this section, together with the sums issued thereout under the authority of section seven D of the *Public Account Act 1957* for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1966 (amounting as appears by the first schedule to the sum of £19,815,000), are appropriated for, and shall be applied for, the works and purposes that are specified in the second schedule.

3 The Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing on behalf of the State, in accordance with the Financial Agreement, of the sum of £17,417,000. Power to borrow moneys.

4 The issue and application, pursuant to subsection (1) of section seven A of the *Public Account Act 1957*, of the sums of moneys specified in the third schedule for the purposes therein specified are ratified. Ratification of certain expenditure.

LAND TAX.

No. 30 of 1965.

AN ACT to impose a land tax.

[28 October 1965.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Land Tax Act 1965*. Short title and incorporation.

(2) This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the *Land and Income Taxation Act 1910* (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act).
