

AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act 1935.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Local Government Act 1935.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting "and expenses" (in the heading to Division X. of Part XI.) and by adding after subsection (2) of section one hundred and seventy-four the following new subsection (3):—
 - "(3) Where the payment of any sum of money has been remitted or excused as provided by subsection (2) hereof, the council may pay the amount thereof out of the municipal fund to any account or for any purpose, to or for which the council would have been required to apply such sum if the same had been received by it.":

II. As to section two hundred and five thereof—

(a) By inserting in division (2) thereof the following new paragraph v.:—

- "v. Regulating the erection and construction of buildings in any specified part of any town and prohibiting the use therein of materials calculated to constitute undue risk of fire either generally or in relation to the intended use of the building or to the surroundings of the building":
- (b) By inserting in paragraph x111. of division (10) the following new subdivision (f) to follow subdivision (e):—
 - "(f) To require the owner or person in charge of any sawmill to produce for inspection by prescribed officers and to permit such officers to inspect as prescribed all tally-books and other records showing the quantity of timber dealt with at such mill.": and
- (c) By inserting after paragraph xiii. aforesaid the following new paragraph xiv.:—
 - "xiv. Regulating the construction of roads and streets for the purposes of the subdivision of land into allotments and prohibiting the sale of any such allotment which is dependent for access thereto upon any proposed road or street until such road or street is constructed as prescribed.".
