No. 2 of 1948.

AN ACT to amend the Legal Practitioners Act [14 April. 1948.] 1896.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Legal Practitioners $Ac\overline{t}$ 1948.
- (2) The Legal Practitioners Act 1896*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Admission of Registrar, or Clerk, of Supreme Court.
