AN ACT to amend the *Mining Act* 1929.
[27 June, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Mining Act* 1940.

Short titl .

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (10) of section sixty-three thereof the following new subsection (11):—

“(11) Where the Minister is satisfied that there are special circumstances to meet which an extension of the period prescribed by subsection (1) hereof is required the Minister, on the recommendation of the Secretary, may grant to the lessee an extension thereof for such further period not exceeding six months as the Minister may determine, but the aggregate period so allowed by the Minister for the removal of the lessee’s property shall in no case exceed twelve months.”
