# AN ACT to amend the Marine Act 1921. [13 November, 1941.]

A.D. 1941.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Marine Act 1941.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—
