AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act* 1921. [14 December, 1944.]

A.D. 1944.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Marine Act 1944.
- Short titl and citation.
- (2) The Marine Act 1921*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Subsection (2) of section one hundred and twenty-eight Special permit of the Principal Act is amended—

 to carry passengers,
 - (a) by deleting the words "the Port of Hobart" (first cargo, &c. occurring) and substituting therefor the words "any port in or over which the Board has jurisdiction"; and
 - (b) by deleting the words "Port of Hobart" (second occurring) and substituting therefor the words "port in or over which the Board has jurisdiction".
