AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act* 1921.
[14 December, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Marine Act* 1944.

Short title
and citation.

(2) The *Marine Act* 1921*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Subsection (2) of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by deleting the words “the Port of Hobart” (first occurring) and substituting therefor the words “any port in or over which the Board has jurisdiction”; and

(b) by deleting the words “Port of Hobart” (second occurring) and substituting therefor the words “port in or over which the Board has jurisdiction”.
