AN ACT to amend the *Marine Act 1921*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Marine Act 1945*.

(2) The *Marine Act 1921**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section sixty-four of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph XI. the following paragraphs:—

“XIA. To provide for the safety of ports and wharves, and of shipping in or at any port or wharf, and to take such measures as may be necessary for the preservation of life and property in or at any port or wharf:

XIB. To provide for the prevention of accidents resulting from the use of vessels of any kind (including rowing-boats and vessels used as pleasure yachts), for the licensing of any such vessels to which Part XIV. does not apply, for the cancellation of licences issued in respect of any such vessels, and prohibiting the use of any such vessels which are unlicensed or of which the licence has been cancelled:”.

3 Section eighty-five A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph II. of subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“II. Which has borrowed any moneys in accordance with the provisions of paragraph II. or paragraph III. of section eighty-four—”.
