# AN ACT to amend the *Medical Act* 1918. [14 April, 1954.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Medical Act 1954. Short title

Short title and citation.

(2) The *Medical Act* 1918, as subsequently amended, is in this Act called the Principal Act.

2 Section fifteen A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (9) the words "no more such licences" and substituting therefor the words "not more than two original special licences in each of the next five years ending on the thirty-first day of December 1959".
