**AN ACT to amend the Mining Act 1929.**

**[5 October 1978]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—(1)** This Act may be cited as the *Mining Act 1978*.

(2) The *Mining Act 1929*\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words “wardens of mines,”; and
- (b) by omitting subsections (3) and (4).

**3** After section 10 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Power to  
appoint wardens  
of mines.

“10A—(1) The Governor may appoint such wardens of mines as he thinks necessary for the purposes of this Act.

“(2) The person holding the office of Director shall be a warden by virtue of that office.

“(3) A warden appointed under subsection (1) is not subject to the *Public Service Act 1973*.”.
