AN ACT to amend the Marine Act 1976.

[5 October 1978]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Marine Act 1978.

Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The Marine Act 1976*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall not commence until Her Majesty's pleasure thereon has been publicly signified in this State, and, after the signification thereof, this Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

2-(1) Section 32 of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

Marine Board of Burnie.

" 32 The Marine Board of Burnie shall consist of 9 wardens, of whom-

- (a) four shall be elected by the electors of the Burnie voting district;
- (b) three shall be elected by the electors of the Wynyard voting district;
- (c) one shall be elected by the electors of the Penguin voting district; and
- (d) one shall be elected by the electors of the West Coast voting district,

as those districts are defined in Schedule III.".

(2) On the commencement of this Act the office of warden referred to in subsection (1) (d) shall, until the next annual election held in accordance with section 44, be filled by an elector of the West Coast voting district nominated by the Minister.

Voting districts.

- 3 Schedule III of the Principal Act is amended---
- (a) by omitting the words "Emu Bay" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "Burnie";
- (b) by omitting the words "Table Cape" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the word "Wynyard"; and
- (c) by inserting after the item relating to the Penguin voting district the following item:—
 - "West Coast—The municipalities of Queenstown, Waratah, and Zeehan.".
