AN ACT to amend the Marine Act 1976.**[30 November 1978]**

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Marine Act (No. 2) 1978*.
(2) The *Marine Act 1976**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall not commence until Her Majesty's pleasure thereon has been publicly signified in this State, and, after the signification thereof, this Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

2 Section 34 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:—

(2) For the purposes of the election of wardens held in 1977 that is referred to in subsection (1) and at which no poll was required, the first and second wardens elected by the electors of a voting district referred to in that subsection shall be determined by lot conducted by the Returning Officer of the Marine Board of Circular Head.

3—(1) As soon as possible after the commencement of this Act, the Returning Officer of the Marine Board of Circular Head shall, for the purposes of section 34 (1) of the Principal Act, determine by lot who are the first and second wardens elected for the Mowbray voting district and the Stanley voting district respectively.

(2) The election of wardens of the Marine Board of Circular Head elected by electors of the Mowbray voting district and electors of the Stanley voting district to be held in the year 1978 that is referred to in section 34 (1) (a) of the Principal Act—

(a) shall be held as soon as possible after the determination referred to in subsection (1) is made as required by that subsection; and

(b) shall, when so held, be deemed to have been held in that year at the time required by section 44 of the Principal Act.
