# MENTAL HEALTH (CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS) ACT 1996

#### No. 32 of 1996

An Act to amend certain Acts in consequence of the enactment of the Mental Health Act 1996

### [Royal Assent 12 November 1996]

Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

#### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Mental Health (Consequential Amendments) Act 1996.

#### Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day to be proclaimed.

#### **Amendment of certain Acts**

3. The Acts specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 are, in the provisions specified in column 2 of that Schedule, amended as specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

## Reports by medical practitioners

**20A.** Before authorising the transfer of a prisoner to a hospital, the Chief Superintendent must have –

- (a) a report from the senior medical practitioner of the hospital that the prisoner would benefit from admission to the hospital and that the admission would not present an unreasonable risk to the safety of the prisoner or to any other person; and
- (b) a report from the senior medical practitioner of the hospital approving the admission to the hospital.
