AN ACT to amend the *Mines Inspection Act 1968*.

[3 May 1973.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Mines Inspection Act 1973*. Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Mines Inspection Act 1968*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting therefor the following subsection:—

“(2) No person shall be appointed the Chief Inspector of Mines or an inspector of mines unless he holds such certificates of competency as not to be precluded, by virtue of subsection (3) of section eleven, from being appointed the manager of any of the mines coming within the classes or descriptions prescribed for the purposes of that subsection.”.

**3** Section twenty-seven of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) the words “ thirty brake horsepower ” and substituting therefor the words “ thirty kilowatts ”; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) the words “ ten brake horsepower ” and substituting therefor the words “ ten kilowatts ”.

**4** Section thirty-five of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsections (1), (3), and (7) the words “ forty feet ” (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the words “ twelve metres ”.
