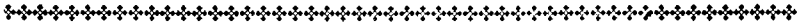

AN ACT to amend the *Mersey Marine Board Loan Act 1936.* A.D. 1937.  
[6 December, 1937.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Mersey Marine Board Loan Act 1937.* Short title.

**2** Section five of the principal Act is hereby amended as from the commencement of that Act by—

- I. Deleting the words “out” to “Revenue” and “so” to “interest” in subsection (1) :
