2 Section eight of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(7) Where the Director is satisfied that a person is competent to act as a tester or grader of any dairy produce he may issue a temporary certificate to that person authorizing him, during such period as may be specified in the certificate, and subject to such conditions (if any) as may be so specified, to test or grade (as the case may be) that dairy produce; and, in relation to any testing or grading of dairy produce authorized by the certificate, that person shall, for the purposes of this section, be deemed to hold a prescribed certificate.”.

Employment
of certificated
butter makers
and cheese
makers.

3 Section twelve A of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

“(3) Where the Director is satisfied that a person is competent to make cheese or butter he may issue a temporary certificate authorizing that person to be employed as a butter maker or a cheese maker (as the case may be) for such period as may be specified in the certificate, and subject to such conditions (if any) as may be so specified; and where in accordance with that certificate that person is employed as a butter maker or a cheese maker he shall be deemed for the purposes of this section to be a certificated butter maker or a certificated cheese maker, as the case may be.”.

MOWBRAY MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL LOAN GUARANTEE.

No. 7 of 1970.

AN ACT to authorize the Treasurer to guarantee the repayment of a loan proposed to be made by the Launceston Bank for Savings to the Association known as the Mowbray Memorial Swimming Pool Incorporated and the payment of the interest payable in respect of that loan, and to pay a certain proportion of the interest payable in respect of that loan, and to provide for matters incidental thereto. [29 April 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the *Mowbray Memorial Swimming Pool Loan Guarantee Act 1970*.

2 In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

Interpre-
tation.

“ Association ” means the Mowbray Memorial Swimming Pool Incorporated, an association incorporated under the *Associations Incorporation Act 1964*;

“ Bank ” means the Launceston Bank for Savings.

3—(1) Subject to this section, the Treasurer may, on behalf of the State, guarantee the repayment by the Association to the Bank of money proposed to be lent to the Association by the Bank that he is satisfied has been or will be applied towards the construction, by or on behalf of the Association, of a twenty-five metre indoor swimming pool and may also guarantee the payment of the interest payable in respect of that loan.

(2) The Treasurer shall not, in pursuance of this section, guarantee the repayment of any principal moneys exceeding the sum of fifty thousand dollars in the aggregate.

(3) Before a guarantee is given by the Treasurer under this section, the Association shall give to the Treasurer such security (if any) as the Treasurer may require and shall execute all such instruments as may be necessary for that purpose.

4—(1) Subject to this section, the Treasurer may, on behalf of the State, pay to the Bank such sums of money as may from time to time be certified by the Bank to be equal to one-half of the amounts payable by the Association to the Bank by way of interest on the principal moneys lent by the Bank to the Association and, for the purposes of this section, may enter into such agreements or arrangements with the Bank as he may think desirable.

(2) A payment that is made by the Treasurer under this section shall be made out of the Consolidated Revenue (which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly).

5—(1) If the Treasurer is called upon to make a payment to the Bank in consequence of giving a guarantee under section three the Treasurer shall, on the demand of the Bank and without any authority other than this section, make that payment to the Bank out of the Consolidated Revenue (which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly).

Payment to

(2) Where, in pursuance of a guarantee given under this Act, the Treasurer is required under subsection (1) of this section to make a payment to the Bank, the Association shall, on demand being made on it by the Treasurer, pay to the Treasurer any amount so paid to the Bank by the Treasurer, together with interest thereon at the same rate of interest as the rate that is payable by the Association to the Bank in respect of the principal moneys lent to the Association by the Bank.

(3) All moneys received by the Treasurer from the Association under subsection (2) of this section shall be paid by the Treasurer into the Consolidated Revenue.
