## ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Power to Council to apply certain sums for certain purposes.



AN ACT to provide for the application to other purposes of certain Moneys borrowed for the Sewerage and Drainage of the Town of Wynyard and now found not to be required for those purposes. [22 July, 1942.]

WHEREAS the Warden, Councillors, and Electors of the Municipality of Table Cape have borrowed certain moneys under the provisions of the *Local Authorities Public Works Subsidies Act 1936* and of the *Wynyard Sewerage Act 1939* which have proved to be in excess by the amount of one thousand and seventy-one pounds twelve shillings and eleven pence of the money required for the purposes for which the same were borrowed, namely, the installation of sewerage and drainage through part of the Town of Wynyard: Preamble.

And whereas it is desirable that the Council should be authorised to utilise such excess loan moneys for other public purposes within the Municipality of Table Cape:

A.D. 1942. Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Municipality of Table Cape Loans Adjustment Act 1942*.

(2) This Act shall be incorporated and read as one with the *Local Government Act 1906*.

Power to Council to apply certain sums for certain purposes.

**2** It shall be lawful for the Council to—

- I. Appropriate and apply a sum of eight hundred pounds from the loan money now held by the Council and standing to its credit at its bank in the account styled the Wynyard Drainage Loan Account and to pay such sum to the credit of the account shown in the Council's books as the Somerset Water Revenue Account for the purposes of—
  - (a) Liquidating an amount of seven hundred and forty-seven pounds eight shillings and ten pence already expended, in excess of the loan moneys borrowed for that purpose, in the installation of a water reticulation scheme throughout the Town of Somerset in the said Municipality: and
  - (b) Enabling the expenditure of a further amount of fifty-two pounds eleven shillings and two pence by way of capital outlay towards completing the said water reticulation scheme:
- II. Charge against the Somerset Water Revenue Account all interest and repayment of loan instalments payable in respect of the said sum of eight hundred pounds and to pay the same from moneys collected by way of a separate local water rate levied over the Town of Somerset:
- III. Appropriate the balance of the surplus loan money mentioned in the recital hereto towards such public works of a permanent nature within the said Municipality as the Council may by resolution decide: and
- IV. Charge against such account of the said Municipality as the Council may by resolution decide all interest and repayment of loan instalments payable in respect of such portion of the said loan money as shall be appropriated in accordance with paragraph III. of this section.
