vacant position, and no further appeal shall lie or be allowed in favour of any officer or employee in respect of the promotion of the appellant in pursuance of this subsection.

(9) Where the Board disallows any appeal under this Division, or no notice of appeal is lodged within the time prescribed in subsection (3) of section sixty B, the Commissioner shall confirm the provisional promotion.

(10) Every determination of the Board on the hearing of any appeal under this Division shall be final.

"60D.—(1) The Board may make any order which it thinks just with respect to the payment of the expenses incurred in or in connection with any appeal under this Division, and may direct by whom and in what proportion such expenses shall be paid, and may, if it considers that the appeal is frivolous or vexatious, order that the appellant shall pay the whole of such expenses or such part thereof as the Board may determine.

(2) Any expenses ordered by the Board in pursuance of this section to be paid by an appellant may be deducted from any salary or wages due or becoming due to the appellant.".

## No. 30 of 1948.

## AN ACT to amend the Miners' Pensions Act 1944. [23 July, 1948.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Miners' Pensions Act 1948.

(2) The *Miners' Pensions Act* 1944<sup>\*</sup>, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

3 Section eighteen of the Principal Act is amended by Contributions by Treasurer. omitting subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following subsection:-

"(1) The Treasurer shall pay to the Board in each year an amount equal to the total amount of the contributions made by owners in pursuance of section nineteen.".

4 Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended by Contributions omitting from subsection (2) all the words after the word and miners. " prescribed " to the end of that subsection.

**5** Section twenty of the Principal Act is amended by insert-Qualification ing in subsection (1) after the word "pounds", the words "twelve shillings and sixpence.".

6 Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words "five pensioners shillings" and substituting therefor the words cases. "seventeen shillings and sixpence"; and

- (b) by omitting from paragraph III. of that subsection the words "five shillings" and substituting therefor the words "seventeen shillings and sixpence ".

**8** Section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words "five pounds" and substituting therefor the words "six pounds five shillings"; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (2) the words "two pounds ten shillings" and substituting therefor the words "three pounds".

9 Section twenty-six of the Principal Act is amended by Limitation omitting therefrom the words "four pounds ten shillings and of amount sixpence" and substituting therefor the words "five pounds fifteen shillings and sixpence".
