“(ba) the fees payable in respect of the registration of persons carrying on the classes of business referred to in paragraph (b);”.

Fees.

7 The schedule to the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph 2 thereof and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“2. On appeal by any person aggrieved by any decision of the censor—

(a) In respect of a film submitted for approval—for every reel of such film or part thereof (with a minimum fee of one pound ten shillings for any one film) 0 10 0

(b) In respect of any advertisement—for every sample copy (with a minimum fee of one pound ten shillings in respect of every sample copy in respect of any one film) 0 10 0”.

McDONALD PENSION.

No. 7 of 1949.

AN ACT to provide for the Payment of a Pension to *Mary McDonald*, widow of the Honourable *James McDonald*, a former Minister of the Crown of this State. [12 April, 1949.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *McDonald Pension Act* 1949.

Short title.

2—(1) There shall be payable and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue to *Mary McDonald*, widow of the Honourable *James McDonald*, a former Minister of the Crown of this State, an annual pension of two hundred and eight pounds during widowhood. Annual pension to Mary McDonald.

(2) Such pension shall be payable monthly as from the first day of July, 1948.

3 The Governor shall issue his warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the pension payable under this Act, and the same shall thereupon be paid by the Treasurer to the said *Mary McDonald* or to such other person as she shall, by writing under her hand, appoint to receive the same. Mode of payment.

NURSES' REGISTRATION.

No. 8 of 1949.

AN ACT to amend the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1927. [12 April, 1949.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1949. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Nurses' Registration Act* 1927*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (4) and substituting therefor the following subsection:— Qualifications for registration.

“(4) Any person who produces to the Board's satisfaction evidence of having been fully or partly trained as a nurse in any part of the world other than this State and who undergoes such supplementary training (if any), and passes such
