

MINERS' PENSIONS.

No. 31 of 1951.

AN ACT to amend the *Miners' Pensions Act* 1944. [18 May, 1951.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title,
citation and
commence-
ment.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Miners' Pensions Act* 1951.

(2) The *Miners' Pensions Act* 1944*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of November, 1950.

Qualification
for pension.

2 Section twenty of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the words “two pounds fifteen shillings” and substituting therefor the words “three pounds seven shillings and sixpence”.

Additional
payments to
pensioners in
certain cases.

3 Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph I. of subsection (1) the words “two pounds two shillings and sixpence” and substituting therefor the words “two pounds twelve shillings and sixpence”.

Pensions to
dependants.

4 Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraphs I. and II. of subsection (2) the words “two pounds five shillings” wherever occurring and substituting therefor, in each case, the words “two pounds twelve shillings and sixpence”.

Limitation
amount of
pension.

5 Section twenty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the words “five pounds fifteen shillings and sixpence” and substituting therefor the words “seven pounds seven shillings”.
