MINERS' PENSIONS.

No. 13 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the Miners' Pensions Act 1944. [20 April, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:---

1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Miners' Pensions short title. Act 1953.

(2) The Miners' Pensions Act 1944, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the second day of October, 1952.

2 Section twenty of the Principal Act is amended by omit- Qualification for pension. ting from subsection (1) the words "three pounds seventeen shillings and sixpence" and substituting therefor the words " four pounds ten shillings ".

- 3 Section twenty-one of the Principal Act is amended—Additional (a) by omitting from paragraph I. of subsection (1) pensioners the words "three pounds two shillings and six- in cortain pence" and substituting therefor the words "three pounds fifteen shillings"; and
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph III. of that subsec-tion the words "three pounds two shillings and sixpence" and substituting therefor the words "three pounds seven shillings and sixpence".

4 Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is amended by Pensions to dependants. omitting from paragraphs I. and II. of subsection (2) the words "three pounds two shillings and sixpence" (wherever occurring) and substituting therefor, in each case, the words "four pounds".

5 Section twenty-six of the Principal Act is amended by Limitation of amount of mitting therefrom the words "eight pounds seven shillings" pension. and substituting therefor the words "nine pounds twelve shillings ".
