No. 29 of 1960.

AN ACT to amend the *Miners' Pensions Act* 1956. [30 September 1960.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Miners' Pensions Act* 1960. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Miners' Pensions Act* 1956, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is repealed.

## JUDGES' SALARIES.

---

No. 30 of 1960.

AN ACT to amend the *Judges' Salaries Act* 1920. [30 September 1960.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Judges' Salaries Act* 1960. Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Judges' Salaries Act* 1920, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January 1960.
