AN ACT to amend the *Miners' Pensions Act* 1944.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Miners' Pensions Act* (No. 2) 1944.

(2) The *Miners' Pensions Act* 1944\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of the Principal Act, such of the provisions of that Act as relate to, or may be necessary for, the appointment of the Board, the preparation and submission by the Board of estimates, the determination of the basis of contributions under the Act, and the calculation of contributions (but not otherwise), shall come into operation on the date of the commencement of this Act, and the Board shall have power to supply to the Commonwealth Prices Commissioner such reports and recommendations as may be required by him for the purposes of subsection (3) of that section.
