

## METROPOLITAN TRANSPORT (PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION).

No. 8 of 1958.

AN ACT to authorize the Metropolitan Transport Trust to pay to *Arthur Douglas Gray* of Hobart compensation in respect of the discontinuance of certain transport services heretofore carried on by him. [ 26 June 1958. ]

Preamble.

WHEREAS on the twelfth day of April 1957 *Arthur Douglas Gray* of Hobart in this State, Transport Operator, agreed with the Metropolitan Transport Trust to cease carrying on certain transport services then being carried on by him between Hobart and Bellerive and between Bellerive and Howrah in consideration of the payment of compensation by the Trust to him:

And whereas by a further agreement entered into on the sixteenth day of September 1957 between the said *Arthur Douglas Gray* and the Trust it was provided that the compensation should be determined by two arbitrators (one to be appointed by each party) or their umpire in accordance with the provisions of the *Arbitration Act 1891*:

And whereas the arbitrators were unable to agree on the amount of the compensation and the amount thereof was determined by the umpire who, by his award, fixed the sum of £6,440 as the amount of the compensation:

And whereas it is desirable to authorize the payment of the amount of compensation so awarded:

BE it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and  
incorporation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Metropolitan Transport (Payment of Compensation) Act 1958*.

(2) This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the *Metropolitan Transport Act 1954* (in this Act referred to as the Principal Act).

Interpreta-  
tion.

**2** In this Act, “the Operator” means *Arthur Douglas Gray* of Hobart in this State, Transport Operator.

**3**—(1) Notwithstanding anything in the Principal Act, the Trust is authorized to pay, out of the moneys at the disposal of the Trust for the purposes of that Act, to the Operator the sum of £6,440 by way of compensation to the Operator for ceasing to carry on the services mentioned in the preamble to this Act. Payment of compensation.

(2) The sum mentioned in subsection (1) of this section shall be paid to the Operator by the Trust within fourteen days after the commencement of this Act.

## JUDGES' SALARIES.

AN ACT to amend the *Judges' Salaries Act 1920*.  
[ 26 June 1958. ]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Judges' Salaries Act 1958*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Judges' Salaries Act 1920*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section two of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the words “four thousand” and substituting therefor the words “four thousand five hundred”; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) the words “three thousand five hundred” and substituting therefor the words “four thousand”.
