

METROPOLITAN WATER.

No. 8 of 1965.

AN ACT to amend the *Metropolitan Water Act* 1961. [22 June 1965.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Metropolitan Water Act* 1965. The first

(2) The *Metropolitan Water Act* 1961, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 The first schedule to the Principal Act is amended by adding, at the end thereof, the following paragraph:— The first
schedule.

“A trunk main from the Ridgeway Reservoir to Kingston with an extension to Margate branching to Howden, together with a pumping station to lift water up to that reservoir, terminal reservoirs, and such other ancillary works as are needed for the supply of water in bulk to the Municipality of Kingborough for the towns of Kingston, Blackmans Bay, Margate, Snug, and Howden, and lands adjacent thereto.”

3—(1) The second schedule to the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:— The second
schedule.

“(a) In the financial year 1962-63, the Board’s municipal revenue shall be contributed by the metropolitan municipalities according to the following percentages:—

Hobart	29.37759
Glenorchy	28.61296
Clarence	36.12146
Kingborough	5.88799.”

(2) This section shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

(3) Nothing contained in this section affects anything that is done or ought to have been done in the financial year in which this section commences or in any earlier financial year.
