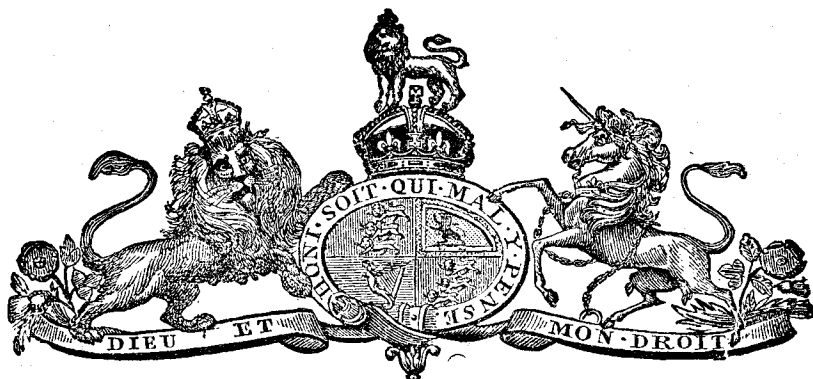

AN ACT to provide for the vesting of certain
land at New Norfolk in the Corporation of
the Municipality. [13 December, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *New Norfolk Library Site Vesting Act* 1934. Short title.

2—(1) The land described in the schedule, now reserved for the purposes of a library site, shall be and is hereby vested in the Corporation of the Municipality of New Norfolk in fee simple.

(2) The said land shall be held by the said Corporation, subject to this section, for such public purposes as the council of the said Municipality may determine.

(3) The said Council shall give effect to the agreement entered into prior to the commencement of this Act between the said Council and the Trustees of the New Norfolk Public Library in relation to the use of the buildings already erected on the said land, and to the existing agreements for tenancy between the said Trustees and the Worshipful Master and Secretary for the time being of the Derwent Valley Lodge, No. 27, Tasmanian Constitution, and the Committee of the New Norfolk Men's Social Club, respectively.

TOWN OF NEW NORFOLK.

1A. 1R. 22P., OR THEREABOUTS.

Being a circle whose diameter is 4 chains 20 links or thereabouts and which forms the centre of the Circus between Richmond and High Streets.
