AN ACT to amend the Official Salaries Reduction Act 1931. [27 November, 1934.]

A.D. **1934**.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Official Salaries Reduction Act 1934.

Short title.

Amend- Section 6. ment of 22 Geo. V. No. 2. 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By expunging subsection (2) of section six thereof:
- II. As to section seven thereof—
 - (a) By inserting after subsection (3) the following new subsection (4):—
 - "(4) The provisions of subsection (1) hereof shall not be construed so as to prevent—
 - 1. The granting of any increment to an officer, if, by reason of any regulation or practice in operation at the commencement of this Act, the same might have been granted to such officer if this Act had not been passed: or
 - II. The increase at any time of an officer's salary to an amount not exceeding the salary paid in respect of the same office at the commencement of this Act.": and
 - (b) By deleting the words "appointment of any officer to any position at a" in the first and second lines of paragraph 11. of subsection (2) and substituting therefor the words "payment to any officer in any position to which he has been appointed or promoted of a"; and by inserting after the word "or" in the third line of that paragraph the words "the appointment of any person":

- III. By deleting the figures "20, $22\frac{1}{2}$, and 25" in the second column of the schedule thereto and substituting therefor respectively the figures "10, $11\frac{1}{4}$, and $12\frac{1}{2}$ ": and
- IV. As to the proviso to the schedule thereto—
 - (a) By deleting the figures "£15" in paragraph n. and substituting therefor the figures "£7 10 0": and
 - (b) By inserting after paragraph x. thereof the following new paragraphs xi. and xii.—
 - "xi. Where any determination made by a wages board applies to the salary of any officer, such salary shall not be reduced under this Act below the amount payable to such officer under uch determination:

graph, the salary of an officer was reduced as provided by paragraph I. hereof by less than one-fifth, the reduction to be henceforth made in such salary shall be one-half the amount of the difference between his normal salary and the salary and allowance payable to him as provided by this schedule prior to the passing of this paragraph, and no allowance under paragraph II. hereof shall be payable in such case."

3—(1) The foregoing amendments in the Principal Act shall have effect as if the same had been inserted therein on the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four, and every additional payment to be made thereunder shall be calculated as from that date.

Application of this Ac.

(2) All such additional payments shall, except where provision therefor is already made, be payable and paid out of moneys to be hereafter provided by Parliament for that purpose.

Validation of certain payments.

- 4 Any payments which have been made between the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, and the commencement of this Act, either
 - r. By way of salary to any officer of the Tasmanian Government Insurance Office and purporting to have been made in accordance with the provisions of the Principal Act: and
 - 11. To the Treasurer by the Manager of the said office by way of reductions in respect of such salaries as provided by section six of the Principal Act—
