

PENSIONERS (HEATING ALLOWANCES)

ANALYSIS

1. Short title and citation.

2. Interpretation.

AN ACT to amend the Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1971. [11 December 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Pensioners (Heating Short title and Allowances) Act 1975.

(2) The Pensioners (Heating Allowances) Act 1971 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

- 2 Section 2 (1) of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting in paragraph (a) of the definition of "pensioner" after the words "age pension" the words ", a widows' pension,"; and
- (b) by inserting after that paragraph the following paragraphs:—
 - "(aa) a benefit from the State as a woman who has the custody, care, and control of a child in respect of which benefit the State receives financial assistance as a participating State under the State Grants (Deserted Wives) Act 1968 of the Commonwealth;
 - "(*ab*) a benefit under Part IVAAA of the Social Services Act 1947-1975 of the Commonwealth as a woman who has the custody, care, and control of a child;".
