AN ACT to amend the *Police Offences Act 1935*. A.D.
1943
 [25 November, 1943.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Police Offences Act 1943*.

Short title.

2 Section fifteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting—

I. “(1)” at the commencement: and

II. “(2) No person shall bathe or swim in the River Derwent at any place within one hundred and fifty yards of the Hobart Bridge.

Penalty: Twenty pounds.” (at the end).
