AN ACT to amend the *Places of Public Entertainment Act 1917*. [27 April, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Places of Public Entertainment Act 1944*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Places of Public Entertainment Act 1917*,\* as amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** After section twenty-four of the Principal Act the following section is inserted— Prohibition of entertainments on certain days.

“**24A** No person shall hold or conduct any indoor public entertainment on Christmas Day or Good Friday.”
