AN ACT to amend the *Police Regulation Act* 1898. [31 October, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Police Regulation Act* 1944. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Police Regulation Act* 1898*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section forty-two of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection— Management of Police Provident Fund.

“(11) The Board may borrow, by way of overdraft from any bank, on the security of any of its assets, any sums of money not exceeding three thousand pounds for the purposes of this Part.”.
