

**PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES AND
ALLOWANCES (ADJUSTMENT).**

No. 87 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances (Adjustment) Act 1951*.
[9 December, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances (Adjustment) Act 1953*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances (Adjustment) Act 1951* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Act the salaries and allowances mentioned in section two thereof shall be paid at the rates current on the twelfth day of September, 1953, without any further adjustment under that section. Suspension of adjustment.

TEXTILE PRODUCTS (DESCRIPTION).

No. 88 of 1953.

AN ACT to make provision with respect to the application of trade descriptions to textile products, and for matters incidental thereto.
[9 December, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Textile Products (Description) Act 1953*. Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.
