AN ACT to amend the Public Works Committee Act 1914. [20 July, 1948.]

Short title and citation. 1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Works Committee Act 1948.

(2) The Public Works Committee Act 1914\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

## LOCAL BODIES LOANS.

AN ACT to amend the Local Bodies Loans Act 1881. [20 July, 1948.]

**B**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title 1-(1) This Act may be cited as the Local Bodies Loans and citation. Act 1948.

Functions of Committee.

Conditions precedent to commencing public works.

House of Assembly may extend Act to works to cost less than five thousand pounds.
