AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works.

[24 May, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Public Works Execution short title. Act 1944.

### Public Works Execution.

#### A.D. 1944.

Power of Minister for Lands and Works to cause works specified in schedul to be ex cuted. Power of Treasurer to borrow £84,770.

- 2 The Minister for Lands and Works may cause the works specified in the schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in the schedule in respect of each work.
- 3 The Treasurer may, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act, borrow any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole the sum of eighty-four thousand seven hundred and seventy pounds.
